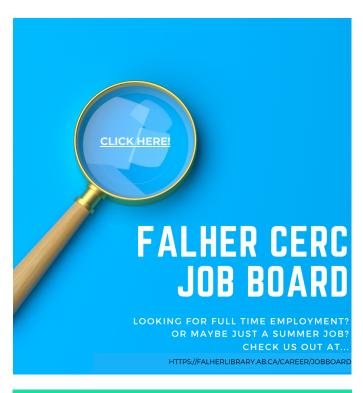

Historical Tidbit for the month of May: Chocolate Chip Day - May 15th

Did you know that chocolate chips were created with the invention of chocolate chip cookies in 1937 when Ruth

Graves Wakefield of the Toll House Inn in the town of Whitman, Massachusetts added cut-up chunks of semi-sweet

Nestlé chocolate bar to a cookie recipe. The cookies were a huge success, and Wakefield reached an agreement in 1939

with Nestlé to add her recipe to the chocolate bar's packaging in exchange for a lifetime supply of chocolate. Initially,

Nestlé included a small chopping tool with the chocolate bars but in 1941, Nestlé started selling the chocolate in "chip" or

"morsel" form. Originally, chocolate chips were made of semi-sweet chocolate, but today there are many flavors such as

bittersweet, peanut butter, butterscotch, mint chocolate, white chocolate, dark chocolate, milk chocolate, and many more.

Chocolate chips can be used in cookies, squares, muffins, cakes, pancakes, waffles, crêpes, pudding, pies, hot chocolate,

and various pastries. Chocolate chips can also be melted and used in sauces and other recipes.
