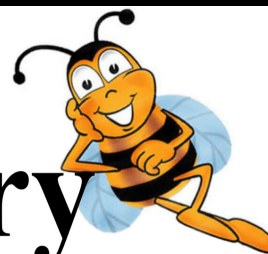

We are currently recruiting to fill Board vacancies. Plan to sit in on a meeting if you are considering joining the Board - it gives you an opportunity to meet the team and learn more about what we do.

FRILB Update:

As you know, the Main Library was closed for two days at the end of September. During this time, taller exterior wall shelving was installed in the Library to better use our existing space. Many thanks to our shelving supplier (Kit Office Plus from Peace River), staff and volunteers who made this happen during this brief closure – [see the next pages for some pictures](#).

This was made possible by a CFEP (Alberta Community Facility Enhancement Program) grant we received in support of our 2018-19 project "To Increase the Accessibility and Usability of the Falher Library / Bibliothèque Dentinger". We are nearing the end of this project, which has focused on optimizing our existing space to meet current needs, ensure sustainability, and increase the accessibility of our facility. To date we have:

- 1) Consolidated and improved the functionality of staff work areas, and provided more privacy for clients, training and meetings (by repurposing and enclosing the kitchen area);
- 2) Updated the Children's Area seating and shelving;
- 3) Upgraded to a new energy-efficient furnace and installed a portable A/C & dehumidifier; and
- 4) Installed new book and literature displays, together with taller exterior wall shelving to better accommodate our growing collection.

CFEP is a matching grant, which recognizes both cash and in-kind contributions.

Cash Contributions

We wish to express our sincere appreciation to the Friends of the Falher Library Society, private donors and AUPE Local 001, Peace River, for both your financial support, and for allowing us to designate and include your monetary contributions to the Library as matching funds for this project.

In-Kind Contributions

Public Works completed work to the building to allow us to proceed with the renovations, and utility efficiency upgrades, to help ensure our long-term sustainability in this location.
